

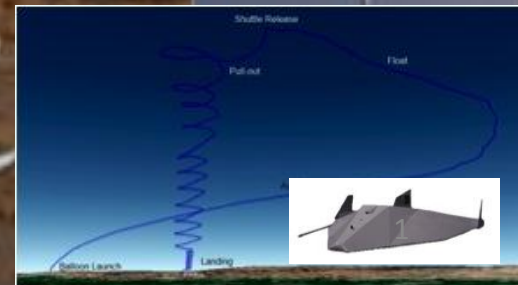

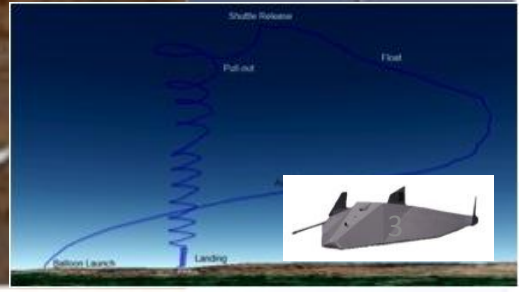
Flight Opportunities Program in a Nutshell

To facilitate maturation of cross-cutting space technologies on behalf of NASA's **Space Technology Program . . .**

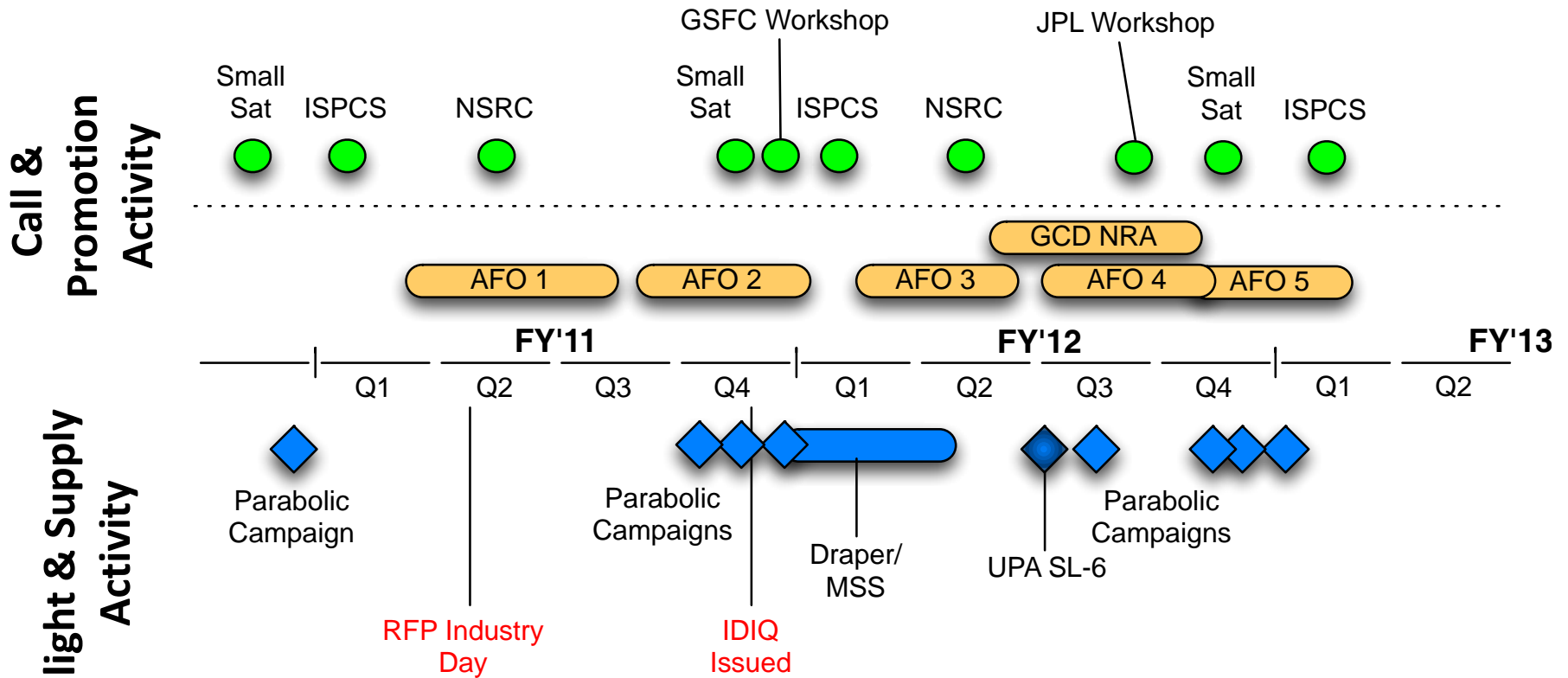
. . . While achieving a goal of the **National Space Policy** to “Encourage and facilitate” the growth of the U.S. commercial space industry.

Fly technology payloads in space-relevant environments using low-cost *commercial, suborbital* space vehicles

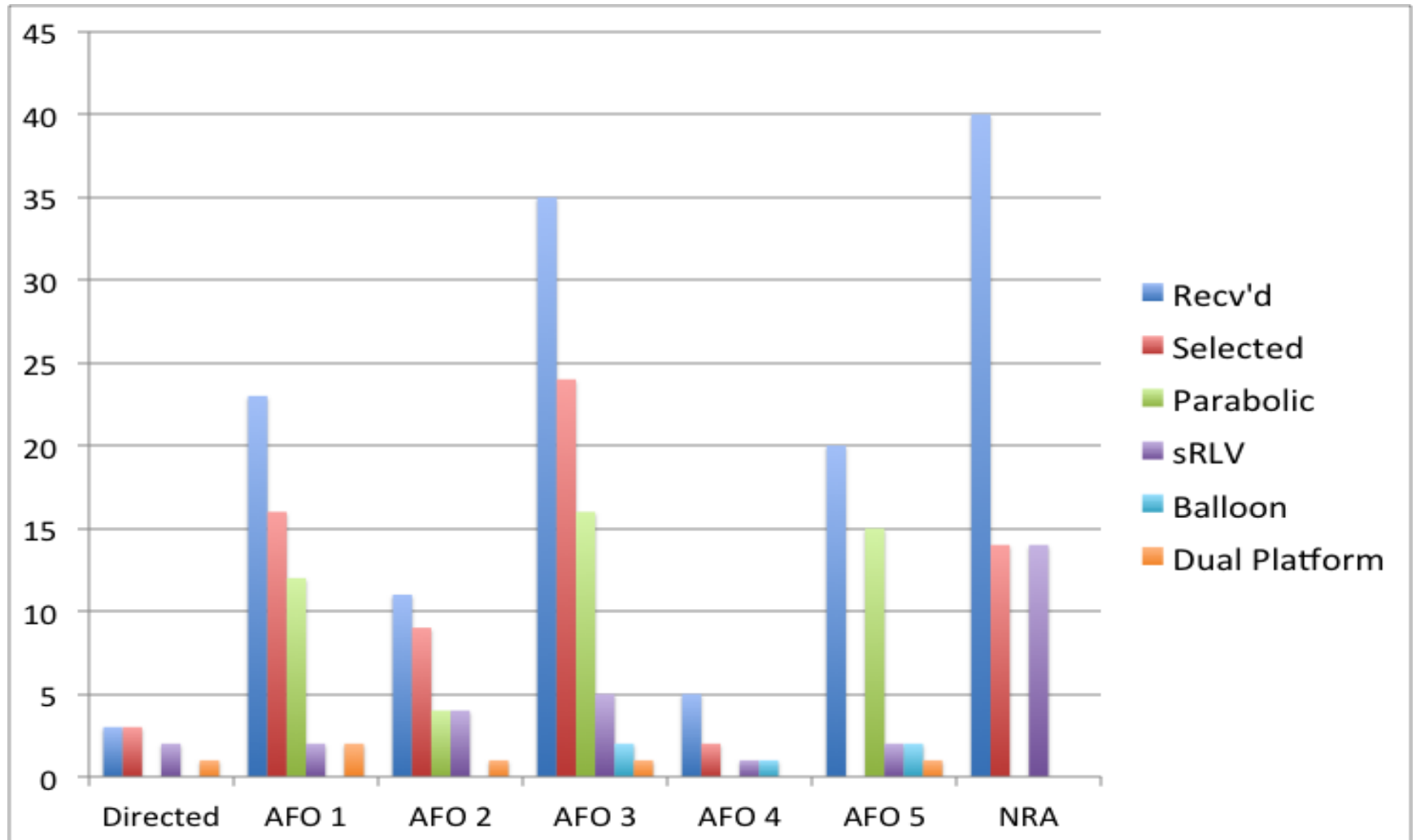


Program Timeline . . .



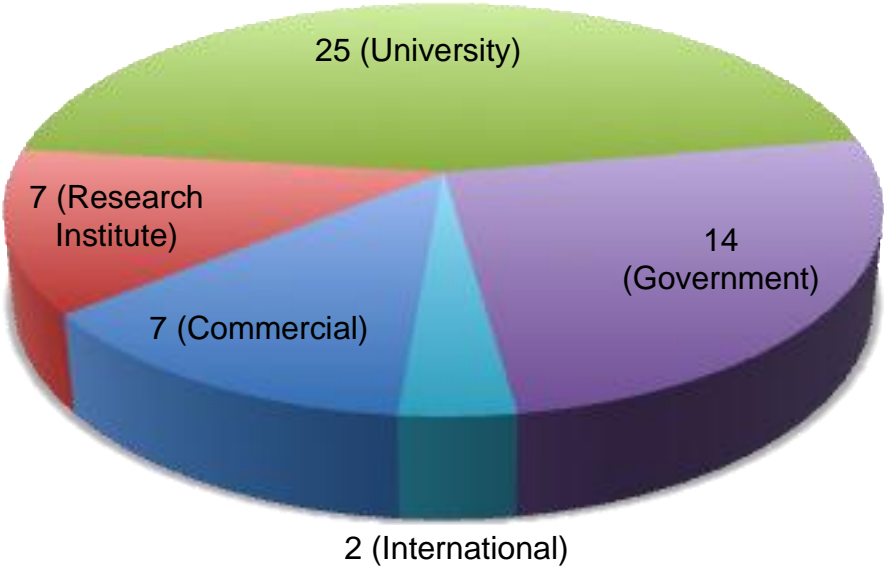

Demand Profile . . .

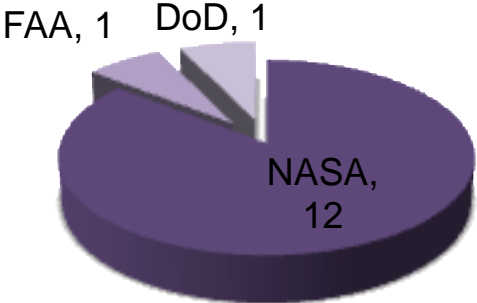


Demanders . . .

By Lead PI Organization*

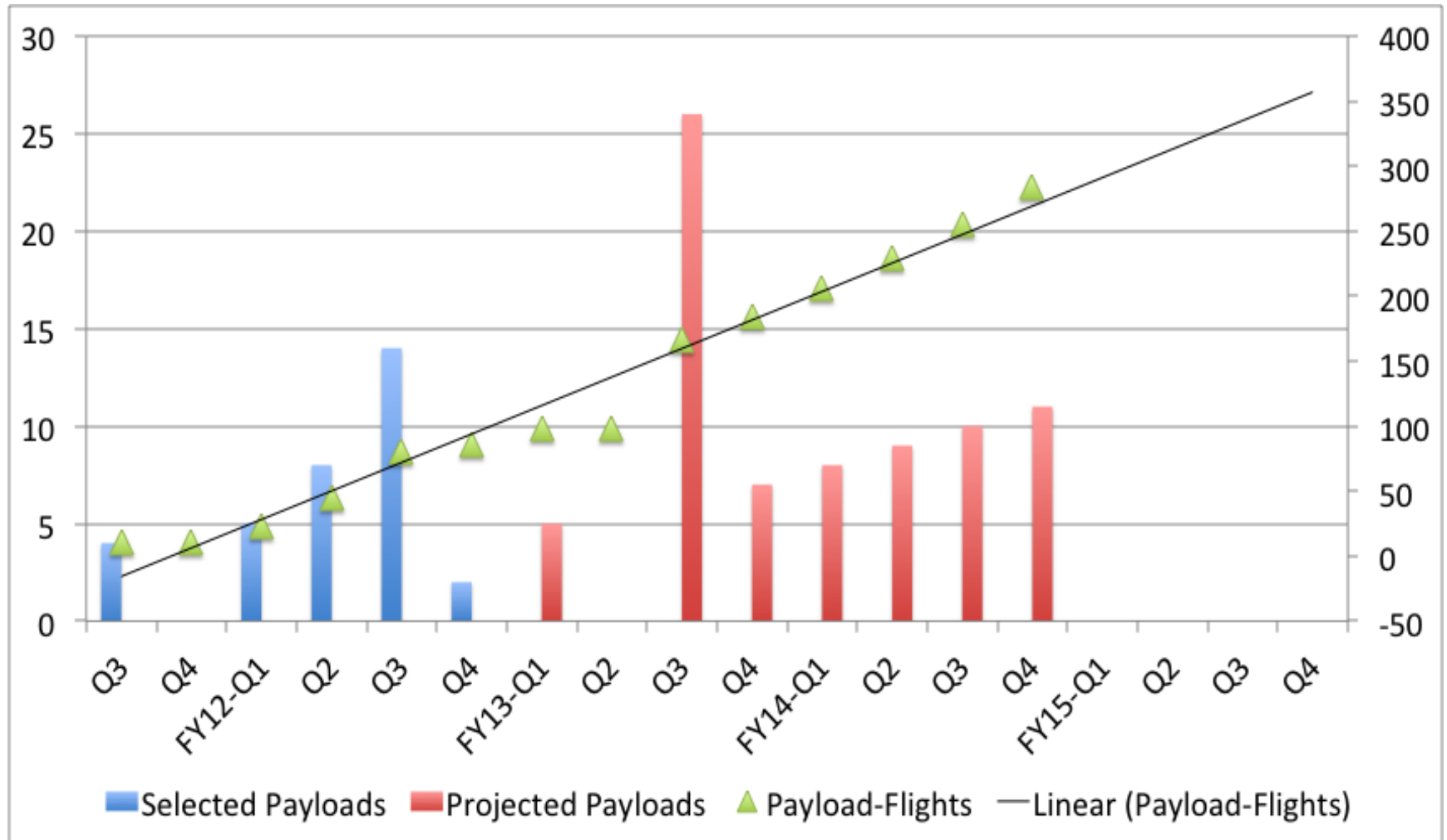
